ACT NOW TO STOP DIY ABORTION UP TO BIRTH

MPs Diana Johnson and Stella Creasy have both tabled amendments to the Government's Criminal Justice Bill that would decriminalise abortion. In different ways, they would essentially legalise DIY abortion up to birth, for any reason. Please contact your MP urgently, asking them to oppose these extreme and barbaric proposals. You can do this using SPUC's webtool, at https://www.spuc.org.uk/abortionamendments. The Bill will be debated on 15th May, so please contact your MP NOW. Please pray for the defeat of these amendments, for protection of unborn babies, and help and comfort for mothers in need.

LIFTING THE FAITH BASED ADMISSIONS CAP

We are delighted and encouraged by the recent announcement from the Government on the decision by the Education Secretary, Gillian Keegan, to lift the faith-based admissions cap on new free schools in England, subject to a public consultation.

The decision paves the way for Catholic free schools to open, having previously been excluded under the 50 percent cap or 'rule' which would have forced schools to turn away some Catholic pupils.

The Bishops' Conference have welcomed this announcement stating,

"Dioceses are well placed to respond to differing local educational demands around the country, including the provision for children with special educational needs and disabilities. Parents can welcome this also. Catholic education not only provides a high performing school sector and promotes the formation of children in values and virtues; it is more ethnically diverse than other schools, educates more pupils from the most deprived backgrounds, and builds social cohesion within our communities."

The Department for Education also has plans to enable new faith-based academies for pupils with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND). The Catholic Church has a long history of SEND provision, in Westminster we host 2 non-maintained Catholic SEND schools who could benefit from this announcement.

We request that you ensure you parish communities are made aware of this consultation and respond via the links below before the closure of the consultation on 20th June 2024.
