RACE ACROSS THE WORLD

'I have run the race to the finish' – it must be great feeling to get to the end of a race, and an even greater feeling to win it. I have recently been following a race on BBC iPlayer. It is called Race Across the World, and five pairs are given a small sum of cash, and their 'phones and credit cards are taken away from them. They have to travel thousands of miles in unknown countries with unknown languages and see who can get to the final check point first. This time they had to travel from Japan to Indonesia. What fascinated me watching form the comfort of my sofa was how the pairs got on with each other and how they made decisions. To win they needed a shared goal, but complementary skills. (Spoiler alert!) The winning pair, Alfie and Owen, was also the youngest pair. They had been friends from school, but they were not carbon copies of each other. Alfie was focussed entirely on winning, while Owen wanted to immerse himself in the local culture. If Alfie had has his way they would have missed out on many unforgettable experiences. If Owen had has his way, they would not have won.

Today we celebrate two very different personalities in Ss Peter and Paul. Peter was a fisherman, from a humble background. We know him for his impulsiveness, for example his bold declaration of faith in the gospel today, but we also know him for his denials of Jesus as well. Paul, on the other hand was a scholar, a man of words and profound energy, travelling tirelessly to spread the gospel. Each one of them reveals Jesus Christ to us.

Their unity (their faith in Jesus Christ) and their diversity (their different personalities and

backgrounds) enriched the Church in a way which rings down the centuries. Our faith is built on their faith. We must celebrate their lives and witness by embracing our own unique gifts and perspectives, which will be unique to each one of us, and work together to build up the Church.
